Non-Profit of the Year

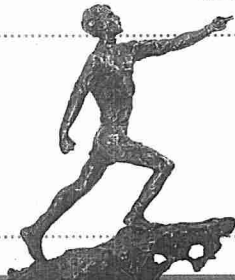


Boys & Girls Club of Greater Lawrence
